**Action:** Notice of Intent to Revise Rule 40-7-5-.02 entitled *Retail Sale of Fresh Seafood, Meat, or Poultry from Mobile Vehicles*

**To all interested persons and parties:**

Pursuant to the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, O.C.G.A. §§ 26-2-412 and 50-13-4, notice is hereby given that the Georgia Department of Agriculture will be accepting written comments regarding the adoption of amendments to Rule 40-7-5-.02 entitled *Retail Sale of Fresh Seafood, Meat, or Poultry from Mobile Vehicles*. The Department will be accepting written comments from July 8, 2019, to close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on August 9, 2019.

**Synopsis, Main Features, and Differences:**

The Department is proposing to amend Food Division Regulations Rule 40-7-5-.02 entitled *Retail Sale of Fresh Seafood, Meat, or Poultry from Mobile Vehicles*. The proposed amendments and rationale are summarized in the table below:

Change	Rationale
Replaced references to 40-7-1-.25 and 40-7-1-.26 with a new reference to 40-7-1-.13.	Rule 40-7-1-.13 contains the language and requirements originally referenced in the repealed Department Rules 40-7-1-.25 and 40-7-1-.26.
Replaced reference to 40-153 with a new reference to 40-15-3.	Fixing a broken reference caused by a typographical error, and correctly referencing Department Rule 40-15-3.
